### **Policy Reminders**

**Fusion Patient Portal.** Log in to your portal account to see appointments, pay and view invoices, and access progress notes and evaluations. <u>https://app.fusionwebclinic.com/portal/Kim4Kids</u>

**Invoices** are sent 30 days after close of each month. Balances will be collected via credit card on file 7 days after invoice is sent. Please review invoices and email office@kim4kidsnola.com if you have any questions.

**No-Show and Late Cancellation Policy.** If you cancel your child's appointment less than 24 hours, not due to an illness or emergency, a **\$50.00 fee** will be assessed.

**Late Arrival.** If your child arrives more than 10 minutes late to their appointment, your child will not be able to be seen and you will be charged the late cancel fee.

**School Convenience Fee.** \$100.00 fee for any child seen off site for the entire school year (August 2024-July 2025) and is not prorated. These fees will begin to be collected in September 2024.

**Doctor Prescriptions.** OT is a prescribed service, and prescriptions are valid for 1 year. To minimize a disruption in intervention, please ensure your child has seen their pediatrician in the last year.

**Consistent Attendance of Therapy is Required**. Quarterly attendance audits are held and attendance **below 85%** can risk losing consistent time slot.

**Two no-shows/late cancellations** in a calendar year constitutes automatic forfeiture of appointment time and placement on flex list.

# THINGS TO DO S

As the beginning of the school year approaches we will be reaching out to schools regarding scheduling therapy on campus

#### Updated IMPORTANT Information and ACTION needed:

- **Complete paperwork** sent in a timely manner to aid speedy scheduling and avoid disruption of services. Updated Kim4Kids, school, and/or Archdiocese forms are needed each school year and will be sent early August.
- Kim4Kids will only send out therapy providers to **schools with 2 or more children** able to be seen sequentially and paperwork has been completed.
- Session Communication Notes. We will continue to send post-session communication via daily note sent through Fusion. Please let us know if you are not receiving these, and we will verify the email address on file.
- **85% attendance standards** are expected for all patients to ensure compliance and success with plan of care. Families are strongly encouraged to reschedule sessions in office when school sessions are canceled due to holidays or school closures.
