New Policies for 2025

📌 Important Update Starting January 1st! 📌

We're updating our attendance policy to ensure we can consistently provide the best care and support to all our patients and families. Here's what's new:

✅ Attendance Requirement Increase:

Attendance will now be required at **85%** (up from 80%).

🔍 Quarterly Attendance Audits:

We'll be conducting regular reviews to ensure compliance with attendance requirements.

🔄 Cancellation Compliance:

If two cancellations occur in a row, at least one of those sessions must be rescheduled within two weeks to remain in compliance with the attendance policy.

💳 No-Show/Late Cancellation Fee:

The fee is increasing to **\$75** (from \$50). However, the fee will be waived if the appointment is rescheduled within the week, based on therapist availability.

🕒 Late Arrivals:

Arriving more than **10 minutes late** for a 30-minute appointment or over **15 minutes late** for longer sessions must reschedule and may incur a missed appointment fee.

Habitual tardiness may result in a move to our flex schedule.

📄 Important Reminder:

Patients unable to maintain consistent attendance will be moved to the **Flex List** as outlined in our policy document.

School Convenience Fee. \$100.00 fee for any child seen off site for the entire school year and is not prorated.

Doctor Prescriptions. OT is a prescribed service, and prescriptions are valid for 1 year. Please ensure that your child has seen the pediatrician within the last year, to minimize a disruption in intervention.

Deductibles restart in 2025.

Cost of therapy sessions will be higher until deductible is met.

Balances more than **30 days past due**, must be **paid in full** or *payment plan established*. If not, your child's therapy services will be placed **on hold** in 2025.

All patients must have a **valid credit card on file**. If a card is declined, we will send an invoice 30 days after the close of the month. Payments are due within 7 days of invoicing.

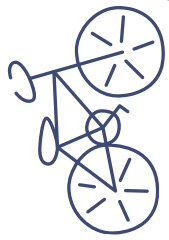

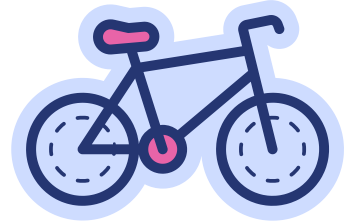

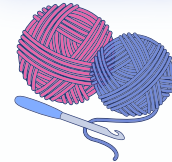
